**Part II - Particulars of Decision**

The East Lindsey District Council hereby give notice in pursuance of the provisions of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 that **outline planning permission has been granted** for the carrying out of the development referred to in Part I hereof in accordance with the application and plan submitted subject to the following conditions:-

1. Application for approval of reserved matters must be made not later than the expiration of three years beginning with the date of this permission and the development must be begun not later than whichever is the later of the following dates:
  - (a) the expiration of five years from the date of this permission; or
  - (b) the expiration of two years from the final approval of the reserved matters or, in the case of approval on different dates, the final approval of the last such matter to be approved;

**Reason:** Required to be imposed pursuant to section 42 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

2. **Condition:-** The subsequent approval of the Local Planning Authority is required to the siting, design and external appearance of the holiday chalets to be erected and the means of access thereto before development is commenced.

**Reason:-** In accordance with Article 5(2) of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 - 81.
