hereby give notice in pursuance of the provisions of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 that **permission has been granted** for the carrying out of the development referred to in Part I hereof in accordance with the application and plans submitted subject to the following conditions:

1. The development must be begun not later than the expiration of five years beginning with the date of this permission.
2. The holiday flats shall not be occupied between the 31st October in one year and the 15th March in the following year.

The reasons for the conditions are:

1. Required to be imposed pursuant to section 41 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.
2. It is the policy of the district planning authority not to permit the permanent occupation of the holiday flats.
