Determination of whether or not prior approval is required for the siting and appearance of the proposed pole to the maximum height of 25m to be installed on a new pad foundation and associated works

Butlins Funcoast World, Roman Bank, Ingoldmells, Skegness, PE25 1NJ

Thank you for referring the above application, which was received on 16 September 2020.

In the absence of a flood risk assessment (FRA), we request that your authority refuses prior approval.

The application site lies within Flood Zone 3 defined by the Environment Agency Flood Map as having a high probability of flooding. Paragraph 103, footnote 20 of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) requires applicants for planning permission to submit an FRA when development is proposed in such locations.

An FRA is vital if the local planning authority is to make informed planning decisions. In the absence of an FRA, the flood risk resulting from the proposed development is unknown. The absence of an FRA is therefore sufficient reason in itself for a refusal of prior approval.

If your authority deems that the proposed development is 'essential infrastructure' which has to be located in a flood risk area for operational reasons and that needs to remain operational in times of flood, then an FRA much be submitted in support of the proposal to demonstrate that the proposal will remain operational during a 0.1% event (2115 scenario) and that appropriate mitigation measures/flood resilient construction techniques have been incorporated into the development. In this case we would expect water sensitive equipment to be placed a minimum height of 4.6m AODN (1.8m above ground level) in order to remain operational during a 0.1% event (2115 scenario).
